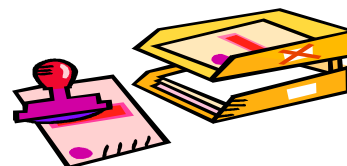

## Scholarships and Deadlines

**EVERY COLLEGE** has scholarships that they offer only to their incoming students. In addition, each particular school within the university may offer scholarships. For example, Indiana University sponsors scholarships that are available to any student attending IU. In addition, the IU School of Education has 3 scholarships that they offer only to the IU students majoring in education. So when you are searching for money to go to college, you must check with the university's admissions office for all scholarships that apply to you and your major. If this sounds confusing, feel free to drop by guidance. We'll do our best to point you in the right direction.

Here is what has come across  
our desk so far...



**Bedford Board of Realtors Scholarship-** This scholarship is open to seniors living in Lawrence or surrounding counties. Applicants must be a child or grandchild or legal guardians of a primary/secondary member of the Bedford Board of Realtors. Applicants must also have a 2.0 or above GPA. Applications are available in guidance. DEADLINE MARCH 15th, 2017.

**Schneck Medical Center Foundation** – scholarship available to students pursuing allied health careers radiology, respiratory therapy, physical therapy, occupational therapy, pharmacy, surgical technology, etc.) Amount of scholarship varies, but several are given to Jackson County students. Applications are available in guidance or on the web at [www.schneckmed.org](http://www.schneckmed.org). DEADLINE IS MARCH 15.

**Phi Beta Psi Scholarship-** This scholarship is open to students planning to enter the fields of Medical Technology, Medical Lab Technology, Radiology Technology, Nuclear Medicine Technology, or Cytotechnology. Applications are available in guidance. DEADLINE IS MARCH 15.

**Jackson County Pork Producers Scholarship-** This award is given to a Jackson County resident with experience or background in agriculture. Pick up an information sheet in Guidance. DEADLINE IS MARCH 22.

**Purdue Club of Jackson County-** Students must be accepted to Purdue University and have a GPA of 3.2 or higher. Applications require an essay and are available in guidance. DEADLINE IS MARCH 24.

**Seymour Noon Lions Club Scholarship-** This scholarship is open to students majoring in Ophthalmology/Optometry/Hearing/Medical/Teaching. It is also open to a career in a youth or related social services career. The scholarship will look at scholastic achievement, financial need, civic and school involvement, and career goals. Applications are available in guidance. DEADLINE IS MARCH 31.

**Schneck Medical Center Guild Scholarship-** candidates must be a past Junior Volunteer of Schneck Medical Center and planning on a career in healthcare. Scholarship packets are available in guidance. DEADLINE IS MARCH 31

- Jackson County Cattleman's Association Scholarship-** Preference will be given to applicants pursuing careers in the Beef Cattle Industry. Applications are available in guidance and require a letter of reference and an essay. DEADLINE IS APRIL 1
- United Producers Inc. Scholarship-** Applicants must be a Preferred Member of UPI or a child or grandchild of a Preferred member. Students must be seniors planning on studying an agriculture related field. Applicants must submit an application and essay. Applications are available in guidance or at [www.uproducers.com](http://www.uproducers.com). DEADLINE IS APRIL 1, 2017
- Health & Human Sciences Scholarship-** This scholarship is open to Jackson County seniors who are planning on studying a career in Health and Human Sciences (eg Dietitian, Home Ec. Education, Child Development, Textiles, Chef School, etc.) Applications are available in guidance. DEADLINE APRIL 1
- Seymour American Legion Post 89 Legion Family Scholarship-** This scholarship is open to graduating high school seniors who will be attending at college or trade school. Preference is given to a descendant of a member or former member of the American Legion. Applications are available in guidance. DEADLINE IS APRIL 1
- Indiana Sheriff's Association, Inc. Scholarship-** Given to students pursuing a career in law enforcement or criminal justice at an Indiana college. Must be a member or dependent child or grandchild of a member of the association. Students must have taken the SAT or ACT. ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED BEFORE APRIL 1 TO THE INDIANAPOLIS OFFICE.
- Brownstown Alumni Association Academic Scholarship-** This scholarship is open to a senior with excellent academic performance and a high level of leadership, character, and community involvement. Applications are available in guidance. DEADLINE IS APRIL 1
- Leslie-Arbuckle-Zimmerman Scholarship-** This scholarship is open to all high school seniors pursuing education beyond high school. All applicants must have a parent (step-parent) or Grandparent (step-Grandparent) that is a current member of the VFW Post 1925 and in good standing with the post. DEADLINE IS APRIL 1. Applications available in guidance.
- Tri Kappa Sorority-** Given to 1 BCHS student. Based on academics, leadership, and financial need. Applications are available in guidance. DUE APRIL 3
- Jackson County Recycling District Environmental Scholarship-** Applicants must be seniors in any Jackson County High School. Students must be able to demonstrate an interest in environmental affairs through an essay of 250-500 words describing the importance of recycling in today's world. Application information is available in the guidance office.  
APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY APRIL 3.
- Jackson County Farm Bureau Inc. Scholarship-** Student must be from a family who has been a member of Indiana Farm Bureau Inc. for a period of 2 years prior to scholarship. The students must also be admitted to an accredited school of higher learning for a degree in agriculture related studies. Applications are available in guidance. DEADLINE IS ON OR BEFORE APRIL 8, 2017.

- Blue & Co. LLC Accounting Scholarship**– Students must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher, and be accepted at an accredited college or university in pursuit of an associate or bachelors degree in accounting. Applications are available in guidance. DEADLINE IS APRIL 15
- Freetown High School Alumni Association Academic Scholarship**- To be eligible for the scholarship students need to have attended Freetown Elem. School for one year, be a resident of Freetown School District at time of graduation, and begin some type of high education by fall 2015. Scholarship application are available in guidance. DEADLINE IS APRIL 15.
- Brownstown Central Classroom Teacher Association Scholarship**-\$500 given to a BCHS student planning a career in education. Students must complete an application, essay, and have 5 teachers complete recommendations. DEADLINE IS APRIL 15 (All applications must be submitted to Miss Workman)
- Sertoma Scholarship**- The Sertoma scholarship is available to any senior that will pursue studies in a health science related field. (Priority is given to Speech/Hearing student, but will consider all health majors) A small essay is required. Applications are available in guidance. DEADLINE IS APRIL 17, 2017
- Sherry's Gift Nursing Scholarship (Sherry Fleetwood Memorial Scholarship)**- This scholarship is open to a senior that plans on majoring in nursing. Students must complete an application and attach a page explaining why they have chosen nursing and what qualities they possess that will attribute to this career. Applications are available in guidance. DEADLINE IS APRIL 18
- PJs College of Cosmetology**- This scholarship is open to new students who have not attended a previous cosmetology institution. Applications are available in guidance. DEADLINE IS APRIL 24.
- Vallonia High School Alumni Scholarship**-This scholarship is open to any BCHS Senior that is from Driftwood Township. Applicants must plan to attend a college or technical school. Applications are

**Jonathon Brewer Memorial Scholarship**- given to BCHS students for any 2 or 4 year college. Not awarded solely on academics. Emphasis placed on citizenship, moral character, church affiliation and financial need. An essay is required. DUE MARCH 15

**Psi Iota Xi Scholarship**-given to a student interested in Speech and Hearing or Fine Arts. DUE April 1

**C. Louis Sommers Scholarship**-open to BCHS students that have participated in athletics in high school DUE APRIL 1

**Russell and Loretta Butt Family Scholarship**– given to BCHS student pursuing education degree. DUE APRIL 1

**William B. Sharp**- (\$1,000) must be in top 10% of class. Based on Academics and good school citizenship. DUE APRIL 15

**Justin Pranger Memorial Scholarship**- given to a BCHS students to attend any 2 or 4 year college. DUE APRIL 15
