

WILLIAM B. SHARP SCHOLARSHIP

William B. Sharp was superintendent of schools at Brownstown from January 1953-1975. Prior to that, he was superintendent at Rockville, Indiana from 1946 to December 1952 and principal at Brownstown High School from 1942-1946. His teaching and administrative career in Indiana totaled 43 years. This scholarship is presented by William L. Sharp, his son, who graduated from Brownstown in 1960.

Amount of Scholarship: \$1,000

Qualified students who are interested in this scholarship should apply to the Brownstown Central High School guidance department by April 15. The selection will be based on the following three criteria:

1. Academic Scholarship (must be in top 10% of class)
2. Good school citizenship
3. Student **must** have attended Brownstown Central High School for at least 6 trimesters.

In applying for the scholarship, the student should write on the following three topics:

1. Academic standing in the senior class, any special academic honors or special courses taken throughout high school.
2. Participation in extracurricular activities and student government, leadership positions in organizations, community, and church activities.
3. Education plans and career goals.
