Brownstown Central High School Winter Event Guidelines 2020-21  
(Covid-19 precautions)  
Updated 12/8/2020

### Promoting Safety at Events

- **Masks** are required during the entire event by those 8 years of age or older, unless eating/drinking or exerting strenuous exercise. Masks will be available for purchase at ticket gate (\$1) if needed.
- Social distancing required; immediate family may sit together.
- Fans are asked to discard their own trash.
- Spectators must exit promptly at the completion of the event.
- Signage will be placed at each entrance promoting Covid-19 safety guidelines for fans.
- P.A. announcements will be made throughout events promoting all safety guidelines and procedures.
- Social media/print media posts of game night procedures/safety guidelines will be made in advance of events.
- Sanitation stations will be available at ticket gates, concessions stands, press box, scorers' table, and restrooms.
- Event staff (supervision, ticket takers, law enforcement, emergency personnel, cleaning staff, and sponsors) will be on hand to aid with the execution of event guidelines.
- Team benches, scorer's table, and media tables will allow for socially distant seating.

### Ticket Sales

- Capacity limits may change according to the Indiana County Color Map.
- If Jackson County is RED – Cash sales will be used at main gym entrance. Fans are asked to bring exact change (\$5 varsity events; \$3 lower level)
- If Jackson County is BLUE, YELLOW, or ORANGE, cashless ticket sales will be used – General admission tickets will be sold electronically (in advance or at the gate) through **GoFan** by credit card or Apple pay, no cash sales. To purchase tickets, go to <https://gofan.co/app/school/IN11189>.
- Everyone, of all ages, must purchase a ticket to enter.
- There will be no season tickets sold.
- Per MSC mandate, scouting is prohibited.
- Ticket gates will open 45 minutes prior to the start of the event.
- Visiting fans should park in main school lot off Elm St. and enter main school entrance #1. Home fans park in gym lot and use gym entrance #3.

### **Concessions**

- Workers will wear gloves and masks.
- Only pre-packaged food items will be served at concession stands.
- Plastic barriers will be installed on the serving counters.
- Social distancing lines will be placed at each stand.

**Seating Capacities** - Seating capacity per the Indiana Department of Health’s County Metrics (color) Map.

**MAIN GYM** - Total capacity = 2,385

“Blue” –50% spectator seating capacity

- Home side – 596
- Visitors side – 596

“Yellow” –50% spectator seating capacity

- Home side – 596
- Visitors side – 596

“Orange” –25% spectator seating capacity

- Home side – 298
- Visitors side – 298

“Red” – Parents/guardians and siblings (living in the same household) of team ONLY.

### **Other Main Gym Safety Considerations**

- Essential staff will not be included in the spectator count (team personnel, cheerleaders, officials, and event workers). If RED, band, drill team, and cheerleaders will not be able to attend.
- The band and BCHS students will sit in the northeast end of the gym, eliminating them from home and visiting spectators. Cheerleaders will be on the northeast end of the floor. The band will be included as spectators.
- 3 sets of restrooms will be available to provide adequate social distancing opportunities.
- Concession stands will be available for visitors (west corner) and home (east corner) of the gym.

**AUXILIARY GYM** - Total capacity = 299

“Blue” – 50% spectator seating capacity

“Yellow” – 50% spectator seating capacity

“Orange” – 25% spectator seating capacity
