**Athletic Event Guidelines 2020**  
**Fan Information (as of 8/17/20 – subject to change)**

- A. Guidelines to Promote Safety (All Athletic Events)
  - B. Concessions (All Athletic Events)
  - C. Home FB games
  - D. Home VB matches
- A. Promoting Safety at Events
- a. Masks will be required to enter all events. Masks may be purchased at the ticket gate for \$1.
  - b. Fans are asked to bring exact change at all ticket gates to limit the exchange of cash between patrons (\$5 admission).
  - c. Season tickets, all-sport passes, and complimentary passes will **not** be sold or used this year to help track the total number of spectators at events.
  - d. Social media/print media posts of game night procedures will be made in advance of events (home and away).
  - e. Announcements will be made throughout contests reminding spectators of mask usage and social distancing. Fans will be expected to wear their masks unless seated and social distanced. Family members may sit together. Masks must be worn when not seated and moving around the facility.
  - f. Student section seats will be marked for available seats for students (yellow marks).
  - g. Sanitation stations will be available at ticket gates, concessions stands, press boxes, and restrooms.
  - h. All spectators must exit the facility at the event’s conclusion. Fans transporting participants should wait for them at their vehicles in the parking lot.
  - i. Social distancing marking will be used at ticket gates, concessions areas, and restrooms.
- B. Concessions
- a. Workers will wear hats/hair nets, gloves, and masks.
  - b. Only pre-packaged food items will be served at concession stands.
  - c. Plastic barriers will be installed on the serving counters.
  - d. Social distancing lines will be placed at each stand.
- C. Football games
- a. Seating Capacities:
    - i. Essential personnel only allowed on the sidelines.
    - ii. Marching Band will be seated in bleachers behind the South endzone.
    - iii. Spectator seating capacity:
      - 1. Home – 250
      - 2. Visitors – 250
    - iv. Masks required in the press box – essential personnel only, with social distancing.
  - b. Ticket Sales – varsity games
    - i. Admission gates will open 1 hour before event begins.

- ii. Vouchers will be distributed in advance to home and visitor participants’ families. Home vouchers may be redeemed to purchase a ticket at the South (main) ticket gate. Visitors’ vouchers may be redeemed to purchase a ticket at the North gate.
  - iii. If there are vouchers/tickets remaining, purchasing details will be announced to BCHS students and to the general public.
  - iv. Home spectators should park in the gym lot off Bridge Street. Visitors should park in the main school lot off Elm Street (north of FB field).
  - v. Spectators are permitted to bring lawn/bag chairs to sit on available track space or grassy areas around the facility to promote social distancing.
  - vi. No pass-outs policy will be in place, encouraging one-way traffic before and after games at ticket gates.
- c. Restroom Facilities
    - i. Restrooms are available at the visitor’s side and the home side of the field.
  - d. Concessions
    - i. Concessions stands are available at the visitor’s side and the home side of the field.
  - e. JV FB games
    - i. JV games will have a capacity of 250 spectators with tickets being sold on a first come-first served basis at the south gate only.
- D. Volleyball Matches
- a. Seating Capacities:
    - i. Main Gym spectator seating capacity:
      - 1. Home (east) side – 250
      - 2. Visitors/home (west) side – 250
  - b. Ticket Sales
    - i. Admission gates will open 45 min. before event begins.
    - ii. Tickets will be sold at the main school entrance (for visitors/home spectators) and main gym entrance (for home spectators).
    - iii. Home spectators should park in the gym lot off Bridge Street. Visitors should park in the main school lot off Elm Street.
    - iv. Those purchasing tickets through the main school entrance (visitors/home) will sit on the west side of the gym. Home fans purchasing tickets at the gym entrance will sit on the east side of the gym.
    - v. No pass-outs policy will be in place, encouraging one-way traffic before and after game at ticket gates.
  - c. Restroom Facilities
    - i. Separate restrooms will be available for the gym’s west side spectators (down west hallway) and home spectators (down east hallway). Restroom use is designed to maximize social distancing between sets of fans.
  - d. Concessions
    - i. A separate concessions stand will be available for those sitting on west side of the gym (southwest corner) and home spectators (southeast corner) of the gym.
